'Pairings' of autographs on items can be very important in terms of future value. In other sports, it could mean Ruth and Gehrig together on a baseball or Bird and Magic together on a basketball. In motorsports, the signatures of Juan Manuel Fangio and Stirling Moss would rate near the top of any all-time list of desirable 'pairings'. Although Fangio passed way in 1995, there is still a chance for you to aquire a dramatic piece of artwork signed

by these two all time greats.

In 1990, this Alan Fearnley painting, entitled 'Fangio', was published in a Limited Edition of 500 signed and numbered prints. It commemorated Fangio's victory in the 1955 Argentine Grand Prix. Each copy was hand signed by Juan Manuel Fangio at that year's Monaco Grand Prix. Recently, Stirling Moss has added his signature to a small quantity of these already highly desirable prints. They are available, first come, first served, for just **\$1,000.00** plus shipping.

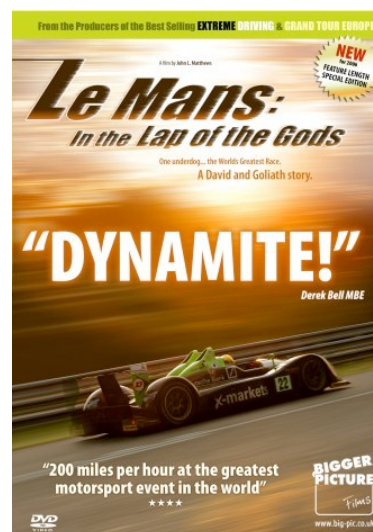

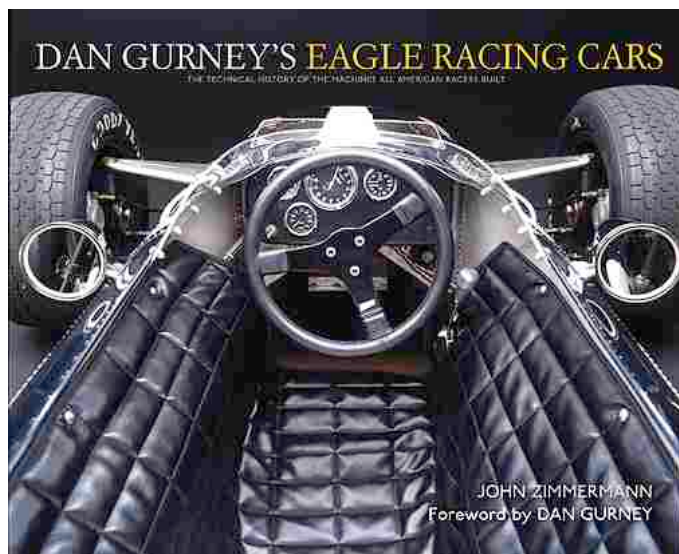

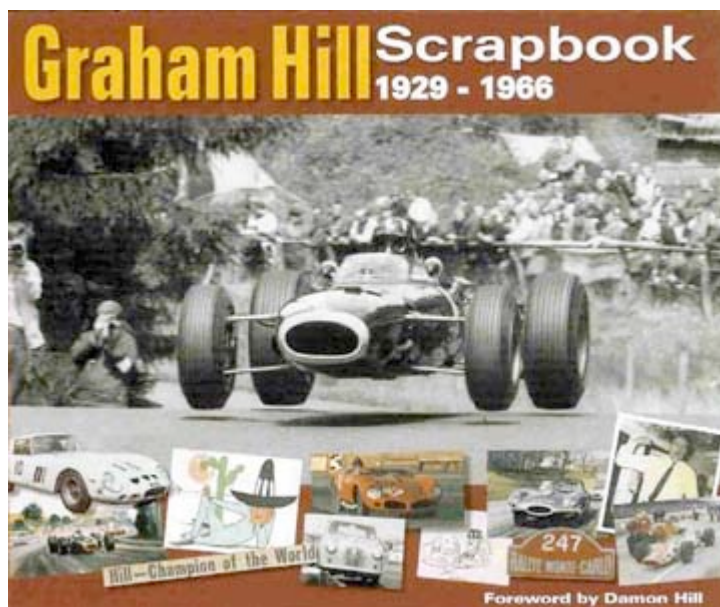
